The after school program meets from **3:30-5:30 on Wednesdays** for five weeks, **starting April 20th**. The program is open to students in **grades 4-5** and will meet in **the small room behind the gym at 3:30**. After a brief introduction, students will be transported to a nearby natural area for a fun-filled and educational afternoon. The **price of the program is \$75** per student for the 5-week session. April 20: Spring is migration time! We'll start learning about what challenges birds face on their epic journeys through an interactive game. We'll also start learning the names of some of the locals!

April 27: How cool would it be to have an owl nesting in your backyard? There are no guarantees, but we'll build an owl nest box and spend the afternoon learning about eggs!

May 4: Ever seen birds exhibiting some crazy courting behavior? Today we'll learn about some of the bizarre ways birds attract a mate, and make and fly a kite!

May 11: What's a raptor? Come learn about these amazing birds of prey through an interactive game. Then we'll see who we can find!

May 18: Today we'll learn about camouflage and birds! We'll play a fun game to see how many of us would be able to find enough food to survive in the wild, make t-shirts and try out our skills at camouflaging ourselves!
